**Additional Policies:**

1. Sick Students: All families will be required to either be able to pick up their student(s) if he/she should fall ill, or have a designated representative who will be available to pick up their student(s), should they fall ill.
2. Medical Policy: The primary symptoms for Covid include fever, cough, shortness of breath, body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea. If any student demonstrates more than one of these Covid symptoms or has only one symptom that is nausea/vomiting/diarrhea, new loss of taste or smell, or fever, that student will be sent home as soon as possible from camp. If the student desires to return to camp he/she will need to be fever/nausea/diarrhea free for 24 hours **and** present a negative Covid test in order to return.
3. Exposure: If a student at camp tests positive for Covid and your student is determined to have been in close contact with the Covid positive student, your student will be sent home and required by CDC guidance to quarantine. Your student will be determined to be in close contact if he/she is rooming with the sick student or was not masked and in close proximity (3 feet) for more than 15 minutes over a 24 hour period.
4. Live Stream: Live streaming of lectures and small groups will be available if your student is sent home either due to illness or close contact.
