

# Crucial Camp Information for Worldview Parents

**Thank you** for choosing to send your student to a Worldview Academy Leadership Camp. We are excited to serve your family and your student at camp this summer!

We will be communicating with you daily during camp via e-mail, but this document will provide necessary information to help you maximize your student's week at camp, so that they have The Best Week of Their Life!

**Check-In & Departure** Camp check-in is from **2:30 - 4:00 pm** on Sunday. Departure is between **11:30 am - 12:00 pm** (before lunch) on Friday. Please join us on Friday at 9:15 am for the last session and subsequent parent meeting. Updated closing information will be sent to you by Wednesday via e-mail.

**Release Forms** The Student Profile/Medical Release is required for your student to attend camp. This form may be completed through your online account at [www.worldview.org](http://www.worldview.org). In addition, there will be a Covid waiver found online and a screening form that can be downloaded from our website. All of these release forms and waivers will be necessary for your student to be able to check in for camp.

**Transportation** Due to airline regulations and safety concerns, Worldview Academy does not offer a camp shuttle service to and from local airports, bus depots, or train stations. If your student is traveling to camp from out of town, please have a local contact identified who could pick up your student from camp if necessary.

**Electronics** All electronics (recording equipment, mp3 players, cell phones, laptops, tablets, e-readers, etc.) are prohibited at camp. The exception here is most cameras. Any prohibited electronics will be collected by our staff on the first night of camp and returned to your student on the final day of camp.

**Lost & Found: Label Everything!** If you believe your student left an item at camp, it probably made it back to our office with us! Please contact our office after August 15th to check. Any lost items that your student would like returned will be sent COD. Worldview Academy is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

**Dress Code** Dress for camp is “camp casual.” Although the dress is casual, all clothing should be modest out of respect for each other. Students may wear loose-fitting shorts or pants and t-shirts. No short skirts/shorts, leggings, crop tops, or thin tank tops are allowed, and all undergarments should be fully covered. Please feel free to bring appropriate outdoor clothing for typical outdoor activities. (Frisbee games, volleyball, color team relay, basketball and other camp games that we may play during the course of the week).

**Withdrawals & Dismissals** The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss any student whose influence and conduct becomes detrimental to the best interest of the program. No refunds will be made for dismissed students or withdrawals. The only exception is a withdrawal on a doctor’s orders, in which case Worldview Academy will issue a \$50 refund for each remaining day of camp. See the "medical" section for details on illness. Students will not be allowed to leave camp for any reason other than an emergency unless prior arrangements have been made with the Camp Director, by the student's parent.

**Cancellation Policy** All deposits are non-refundable. Students canceling more than two weeks prior to their camp session will be refunded their entire camp fee, less the non-refundable registration deposit. Students canceling within two weeks of their session will forfeit all fees collected. If cancellation is necessary, please contact us by phone.

**Roommate Requests** We cannot consider a roommate request unless the request is made through your online account two weeks prior to your camp start date. We typically do not allow students to room together who are more than twelve months apart in age. However, due to concerns around Covid, siblings or close friends who are more than one year apart who want to reduce their exposure to others in camp may request to room together despite being more than twelve months apart in age. We cannot guarantee any roommate requests.

**Media Release** Each day at camp, we post a variety of “life at camp” images on the Worldview Academy website. It gives families a chance to see what is happening at camp daily. Some of these images may be used on Worldview Academy's marketing material such as the camp brochure and promotion-al DVD. Your student's involvement at camp indicates your consent to this activity.

**Responsibility** Every effort will be made to provide the safest environment possible. However, Worldview Academy, its directors, staff and associates can assume no responsibility for accidents, illness or loss of personal equipment, by fire, theft, or student's carelessness.

**Use of Phones** Student cell phones are not allowed at camp – **there are no exceptions.** Cell phones brought by students will be collected the first day of camp and returned at the closing of camp. Students may, however, use the camp phone anytime they would like. Students will only be allowed to call home, immediate family members, or others authorized by you, the parent.

If you need to reach your student at any time, day or night, please contact your student's Camp Director. Your student's Camp Director information is listed in the bottom right hand corner of this page.

**Safe Campus** We take very seriously the safety and welfare of your student while they are at camp. Consequently, we will conduct a security search the first evening of camp. If prohibited items from our packing list are found, they will be collected and returned to the student at the end of camp. There will also be a safety briefing during camp orientation outlining emergency procedures.

**Mail** We strongly encourage you to write to your student. Please keep in mind that mail on campus can sometimes get delayed, so e-mail is the best way to communicate. Emails will be printed and delivered each day to students.

## Medical and Prescription Medication

Should your student become ill while at camp, they will be treated with the utmost care. With the prevalence of Covid-19, our medical policy has been updated.

The primary symptoms for Covid include fever, cough, shortness of breath, body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea. If any student demonstrates more than one of these symptoms while at camp or has only one symptom that is vomiting or diarrhea, new loss of taste or smell, or has a fever, that student will be sent home from camp. If the student desires to return to camp, they may do so if the student is fever/nausea/diarrhea free for 24 hours and can present a negative Covid test.

Students who are not demonstrating Covid symptoms or who are only demonstrating one symptom will be allowed to stay at camp and be taken care of with great care. We will be in touch with you the parent immediately and we will seek to carry out your wishes when our policy allows this to be done.

All prescription medications must be labeled, placed in a "Ziploc" bag, and turned into the "Medication" table during check-in. One of our directors will oversee the administration of all prescriptions throughout the course of the week. All medications will be returned to students Friday morning of camp.
